



Earth's Energy Grids

How can we identify the layers of growth personally, socially and globally? What are the signs missed; the truths being denied? Political science, history, politics, psychology, ancient civilisations, alien contact, the new psychedelic revolution, cryptocurrency and other disruptive and distributed technologies, and much more.

This is Future Sense.

Nyck: You are tuned to BayFM, live from the studios on the easternmost point of Australia and broadcasting out via the web www.bayfm.org. You can tune in any time on demand to any show, and via podcast for this show on the same day or very shortly after of the edited version of the pieces that we talk about.

We're going to move on now and talk about energy grids.

Steve: Energy grids, yes. Over the weekend, I had a look at a video which was very recently published by Lee Carroll and Monika Muranyi. Monika Muranyi is actually an Australian who travels and works with Lee, and Lee is best known as the channel of an entity by the name of Kryon, who is from another dimension of reality.

I thought I'd just take this opportunity before we dive into the material about the energy grids, just to say that I've been focused on human consciousness and its evolution for quite a long time, working with Clare Graves's very down-to-earth research data since 2003; and everything that I've come across has pointed me to the concept that as we evolve—as our consciousness evolves; as we grow—we become more aware of and we interact more with other dimensions of reality, and we pull that awareness into everyday life here in 3D on Earth. If you look at all of our mythology, all of our spiritual stories and books, they all talk about advanced beings who come from another dimension. They don't originate here; they always come and visit us from another dimension. Everything that I've ever come across points to the fact that the future of our evolution is taking us into other dimensions and quite likely, eventually, completely beyond this physical existence here on Earth. I think that's a quite a foundational issue, and I just wanted to lay that down before we start talking about the energy grids, because they are very much related to human consciousness and the evolution of our consciousness.

In this video, Lee and Monika talk for most of the video—and at the end, Lee channels Kryon for a short while—and what they're talking about is material that's come through previously in messages from Kryon. They started out talking about what's called the Magnetic Grid, which is just, as you would imagine, the grid that our compasses point to on the surface of the Earth; and then two other grids: one called the Crystalline Grid, which is a grid which stores memory of human experiences; and then the third grid is called the Gaia Grid, which is kind of like a storage place that holds wisdom in the Earth that we can interact with.

Nyck: That's what they call a partnership grid, isn't it? That's the key about that particular formation.

Steve: That's right, because it's very much there for us to interact with.

So we'll start out with the most down-to-earth, excuse the pun, which is the Magnetic Grid, something that we were all most likely taught about at school. It's created by the molten centre of the Earth, producing a magnetic field. It's very much related to consciousness, and there's a lot of really solid science to back this up now.

One body of science is the HeartMath research into how human consciousness affects the magnetic grid on the Earth, and they've done a great deal of research, some of which has been done in conjunction with Princeton University through the Global Consciousness project, where they put random number generators attached to computers all the way around the Earth and just correlate fluctuations in the random generation of numbers with emotional events happening on the planet. One of the most significant differences or changes they saw in that study was on 9/11, when everybody, of course, was glued to their TV sets or actually in New York as you were, Nyck, and being heavily impacted emotionally by that particular thing. It changed the generation of random numbers across this whole system.

Nyck: That was based in Princeton University, I think. I remember that actually, because of that information, because I was already plugged into these kind of things at that time. I remember hearing about that within a week or two of it happening—that there'd been this enormous spike and it actually had happened before 9/11 hadn't it? It happened the day before or some hours before the actual event itself. There was this massive spike in the numbers of that measurement.

Steve: That's right, and that's in line with other research that they've done where they'll put a person in front of a TV screen and show them traumatic pictures. What they find is that the human response comes very, very shortly before the picture appears, so there's some precognitive activity going on there. So that's certainly in line with that.

Another area where there's some really solid science around this stuff is in space travel. They said in the video over the weekend that the Russians were the first ones to cotton onto the fact that when we travel into space, we are somewhat separated from the Earth's magnetic

grid and that can affect our health. Eventually what they did was, they developed small resonators called Schumann Resonators, which astronauts now carry into space, which gives them a frequency simulating the Earth's, or a part of the Earth's magnetic field, that they carry with them, and that allows them to travel in space.

Nyck: Which is extraordinary, isn't it? That shows straightaway that we are connected to these electromagnetic resonances on the planet—the Schumann Resonance being the one that's most well-known. It originates from the oscillation in the hollow space shell and the average frequency is about 7.83Hz. We'll come back to the Schumann Resonance, but just that fact—and this is from NASA; NASA actually does this—they send Schumann Resonators in space with astronauts in order to keep them healthy, because if they don't have that Schumann Resonance operating, they get sick. In fact, there's also been some research into taking people underground for a period of time without the Schumann Resonance affecting you, and people getting unhealthy quite quickly, and then bringing that Schumann Resonance back in and they start to rebalance again.

Steve: Yes, absolutely. In the video I watched over the weekend, Lee said that the magnetic field of the Earth is very, very much critical to our consciousness, and what I wanted to do was just to take a bit of a sidetrack and provide a little bit more information than what you'll find in the video. We will post a link to that video, which is free to watch online, and if you just give them your email address, they'll give you a free link and you can watch it. Just to add a little bit more science to what was provided in the video, a number of studies have found that parts of our body—our physiology—resonate with these natural frequencies of the Earth, and in particular, neurobiological studies have shown that the resonant frequency of the hippocampus inside our head is actually 7.83Hz, which has been for a long time, the consistent frequency of what they call the Schumann Resonance, which is part of the Earth's electromagnetic field. In particular, the Schumann Resonance is impacted by electrical storm activity in the Earth's atmosphere, so essentially it's kind of like a heartbeat of the Earth. I'm reading from a scientific paper here and they're saying that NASA became very interested in this frequency as a result of the issues that they were having with space travel, of course—and actually, in this paper, they're calling it the Earth's "heartbeat".

As we often report on this show, there have been great fluctuations to the Schumann Resonance frequency over the last couple of years. We are in a time where human consciousness is shifting and also the Earth's magnetic field is shifting. There's evidence that we talk about on the show from time to time of the magnetic pole wandering at this very moment. And so all of these things are interconnected, and in fact, there's this wonderful scientific evidence to show how interconnected and how reliant we are on these natural frequencies that the Earth exhibits. Of course, we have magnetic crystals in our brain, which are actually crystals of magnetite, so we are being physically impacted by these electromagnetic signals, and the same across the animal and bird world as well. This is how many animals are able to navigate using just their brains, and it's often been suggested that

birds can actually see the magnetic lines as they fly, again, because of these magnetite crystals that they have in their brains.

Nyck: So what we're saying here, in essence, is that humans are waking up to this capacity in ourselves, and the science is coming in, even though it's still edgy science to some people—to many people—but science is starting to show that we are that connected to these kind of resonances, just like the rest of the creatures on this planet. We are actually part of Gaia, if you will.

Steve: Exactly. This paper that I'm reading from is called *Innovative Technical Implementation of the Schumann Resonances and its Influence on Organisms in Biological Cells*, and it's by a few scientists from Germany and Romania. I will post a link on our social media to this paper because well worth a read—some really good stuff in here (<https://iopscience.iop.org/article/10.1088/1757-899X/564/1/012081/pdf>). It's talking about around 120 scientific studies which have been conducted since 2003, which show a correlation between solar activity and homeostatic modulation in humans—in other words, alteration of our frequency; our hormonal balance, as well—as a result of variation in other life conditions. It points to the fact that the Schumann Resonance oscillates, usually within a band of about 1-40Hz, although over recent times there have been some spikes up to 99Hz which have been happening, and again, this is very much connected with the Earth's magnetic field and also the Sun's magnetic field, which normally provides a protective barrier around the Earth and protects us from interstellar radiation of various frequencies. At the moment, with the Grand Solar Minimum commencing, the Earth's protective barrier is much thinner than it usually is because the sun's solar wind isn't blowing over us like it normally does, and it's impacting everything, including us.

This article is talking about the wavebands of our brain, also called states of consciousness. So these are particular frequencies that our brain oscillates at, which correlate with different states of consciousness. There's the delta waves, which is the smallest frequency, and is characteristic of dreamless deep sleep, trance and comatose conditions. That's from about 0.5-3Hz. Then theta waves, which is characteristic of the dreaming state—the unconscious—4-7Hz; alpha waves, which occur in relaxed wakefulness like we are right now, such as in light meditation or shortly after falling asleep—wake up, Nyck—or immediately after waking up, at 8-14Hz; and then beta waves, 15-38Hz, which is the normal wakefulness state when you're concentrating and not resting. All of those frequencies are within that Schumann frequency band, and what's really interesting is that there's clear evidence that the Schumann frequency is spiking. As I said before, I've seen spikes up to 99Hz over the last year or so, which is no doubt connected with the shift in human consciousness which is going on.

I remember some years ago when I was doing some training in Clare Graves's material, and it was particularly when I had a wonderful colleague of mine, Christopher Cook, who's based in the UK, came to my office in Melbourne to run an advanced training course. We were training people to train other people in Graves's material, and part of the way that he presented the material was to talk about the layers of consciousness as frequencies and to think of them as frequencies, and I think that's a very, very useful way of thinking of them.

When you consider that our value systems are actually based in frequencies—our framework for understanding a reality is based in frequencies—then it makes a whole lot of sense that all of these things we're talking about can impact human behaviour, human values and human consciousness. At this time when everything is shifting so quickly on the earth, including human perspectives—and this is very obvious when you look at the number of people who are standing up and saying things need to change; we can't continue to live the way that we have on this planet for a whole lot of reasons—then you can see the interconnectedness of the impact of space weather, the changes in solar wind that normally protects the Earth, the changes in our own magnetic fields here on the Earth, and the changes in our own consciousness are all very much part of a whole systems shift that is going on and that we are part of and living through.

Nyck: In fact, going back to Kryon that you mentioned earlier, one of his earlier channels talks about the magnetic grid of the planet being complicated, but as a delivery system to humanity in the sense that it creates the template for us to evolve from within, and as that changes, it offers the opportunity for us to grow into a bigger expression of ourselves, essentially. That's pretty interesting. So what we're talking about here is the potential that not only we're becoming aware of our linkage to these frequencies and resonance with these frequencies, but that they themselves are changing for a reason, and that reason is to do with our own consciousness and our own evolution in some way, and the interaction between the two.

Steve: Exactly. Interestingly, in the video, Lee spoke a little bit about exposure to magnetic fields and made the point that magnetic fields can be both healing or harmful to humans, and a lot of the difference has to do with the time of exposure. So sometimes if you're exposed to magnetic fields for too long, they can be harmful, and also particular frequencies can be harmful as well. This correlation with the frequencies of our brainwaves and our states of consciousness also points to the fact that if you sit in a magnetic field that's of a particular frequency, then it's going to disrupt your experience of reality in some way, and also potentially disrupt your bodily systems.

As I was reading before from that scientific paper, it was talking about the disruption of hormonal balances due to frequency exposure. Lee held up a little electromagnetic frequency or EMF meter that he bought from Amazon—I think he said it was about 30 bucks or 50 bucks or something—and held it next to a mobile phone, like right actually on the phone, and just showed how it went a bit crazy, saying that there was quite a strong electromagnetic field next to the phone. But he has said before—and this has come directly through from Kryon—that as a general rule, if you are more than half an arm's length away from the mobile phone, then the EMFs, for most people, will be quite acceptable and not harmful. But I would just put in a qualifier there in that some people who have particular medical conditions can be more sensitive to these electromagnetic fields than others.

Nyck: And we know some of those people, and all love and kudos to you, too, because you've been battling a pretty strong thing with the way that the technological world is expanding and some people are seriously affected by EMF radiation of one type or the other, and that's a truth. It does happen for some people. It's tough stuff.

Steve: Indeed.

So just to finish off what they said about the Earth's magnetic grid, also known as the energy grid, it has moved, as we said before, and Lee said it has to move to prepare for the new consciousness.

Nyck: Yes, indeed.

We've got a couple of texts in regarding this and some other things. Sandy's written in and said: "The Schumann Resonance. If we are impacted in space travel and if under the Earth, I wonder if people are negatively impacted by living in high-rise buildings. Thanks for another great show, Sandy." Yeah, good question.

Steve: Yes. There was mention of being in a high-rise building, actually, and the general message that Lee and Monika were giving was that it doesn't really matter whether you're on the 70th floor or whether you're on ground level, you're still sitting within the Earth's magnetic field and you can still access these other magnetic fields that we're about to talk about as well. So everything by degree, and certainly if you were barefoot on the ground, you're going to have the best connection possible. I think something most people would identify with would be, particularly if you don't live in the city, is when you go and visit one of those giant shopping malls and walk around for an hour inside all the magnetic fields in there from all the lights ...

Nyck: It's so true. I feel like shit in those places.

Steve: I often start to feel like I'm going into an altered state of consciousness after I've been in there for a while.

Nyck: It's true. Same thing. Maybe you do too out there. I think you probably do.

Steve: Yes, but humans are amazingly adaptable and a lot of people work in those places and tolerate it, so it's pretty amazing what the human body can put up with when it has to, and adapt to.

Lee was saying to avoid overexposure, for example, through phones. So if you can avoid it, don't hold your phone up to your head for hours every day. He did say that bluetooth

earbuds or earphones are much better than holding a phone up to your head—and I certainly always use my earbuds these days when I'm making phone calls.

As I mentioned before, magnetic fields aren't all bad. So it's easy to start thinking that they're just a bad thing that needs to be avoided, but of course, there are many healing devices out there which are based around magnets, and also some evidence to suggest positive genetic changes—constructive mutations, in other words—that have happened throughout our evolution as a result of exposure to different frequencies.

Nyck: Big topic, indeed.

We'll take a break and come back and talk about some of the other energy grids that Kryon talks about and that do exist.

A couple of other texts that have come in, just going back quickly, regarding the coronavirus: "Rather than worrying about how to cure it, perhaps we should look at what caused it - killing innocent animals in outdoor markets. Go vegan and cure lots of problems on the planet." Maybe.

Steve: Yes, there's certainly been a lot of commentary on that in the media—the fact that the conditions in these markets are really not humane and are very dirty in terms of things easily being contaminated.

Nyck: Indeed. And thanks Trace for enlightening regarding these silicon toe dividers. They are for bunions, apparently. That's very important information.

Nyck: You're here on Future Sense with Steve McDonald and myself, Nyck Jeanes. If you're listening to us anywhere out there in the world via the podcasts or online, hello to you. Thanks for joining us here. If you haven't tuned in to the podcast, you can do so via www.futuresense.it. In this section we're talking about the magnetic grids of the Earth and the Schumann Resonance and other resonances and our relationship to them as creatures on this planet.

Steve: Much of this information has come from a video I watched over the weekend, which was put together by Lee Carroll and Monika Muranyi—Lee Carroll being the medium who channels Kryon—and the information that they were conveying was material that had come through from Kryon over a period of time, and I found it extremely valuable. It really does join the dots between some very down-to-earth science and some regular understanding in terms of magnetic fields. If you've ever used a compass, that's what we're talking about, or have been talking about so far—the Earth's magnetic grid, which is related to the molten

centre of the earth and the movement of that material; and also the resulting movement sometimes of the magnetic grid that our compasses point to.

There has been wandering—the North Pole has been wandering a bit—much more than usual. In my work in the military and also in aviation, I very much had to be looking at a compass very often, and it is taught that there's a natural shift of the magnetic field that usually can easily be averaged out and applied mathematically. We had something called Grid North, which you would get on a paper map—back in the days of paper maps—and then Magnetic North, which is what the compass points to. There would be a difference in those two things based on the time that had elapsed since the map was made. So the map would be made according to the magnetic grid at the time and then you would get this what they called magnetic variation, which is usually in the order of maybe one or two or three degrees a year, depending where you were on the Earth. So as a navigator, you would have to note the magnetic variation and then multiply how many years it had been since the map was made to then convert that to Magnetic North so what your compass pointed to would be what you would expect it to be pointing to on a map. We're living in a time at the moment where that's shifting unusually fast and we don't know whether that is what's called a 'magnetic excursion', which happens from time to time where it just goes wandering for a while and then settles down again, or whether it might be the precursor to a larger pole shift, although I haven't seen any messages or indication of an impending pole shift at this point.

Nyck: But pole shifts have happened on the planet before, so it's not out of the purview of possibility.

Steve: They certainly have, yes.

So, there were three grids discussed in the video from Lee and Monika: this Magnetic Grid, and the next one is called the Crystalline Grid. That probably sounds a little new agey to a lot of folks out there, so I thought I'd just put a little bit of science around it again and remind you that many of the electronic devices that you use every day have crystals in them. The interaction between electric fields and those crystals is used for various ends, one of them being to keep time. The science of that is that a crystal has a very regular organisation of its molecular structure, and because of that reliability of the structure, it can be a useful resonator. So when you expose the molecules to an electrical field—and we're talking here generally about the electromagnetic spectrum; The difference between electricity and magnetism is, in my understanding, generally that the two waves—so an electronic electrical signal and magnetic signal as we measure them—generally operate at right angles to each other, and this is why we can use magnetism to induce electrical energy within things, like those things that you have on your bike when you pedal the pedals and it makes the light happen and that kind of thing. So we have them in all sorts of devices, including our phones and our watches and those sorts of things where they are built so that there's a small electrical charge which is causing a response from the crystal, and what happens is that the crystal's molecular structure gets distorted by the field created by the electrical charge, and then when the electrical signal is taken away, the crystal itself actually produces an electrical signal when it springs back into place. This is known as resonance.

Nyck: It's also interesting, because it's also a bit of a memory, isn't it? It's a bit of our memories right there, isn't it?

Steve: Absolutely it is.

Nyck: I guess it's actually remembering something that's just happened a little while ago and now it's producing something from that.

Steve: It's essentially playing back the signal, and that's directly relevant to something that we're just about to talk about from this video. So the Crystalline Grid is something that's also known as the Remembrance Grid because it stores information and it can play back information. Those of you who haven't heard us talk before about the possibility that extraterrestrials were visiting us many, many years ago and had some hand in our evolution, that topic came up in this talk as well. Lee and Monika were saying that during that time—and this is before recorded history as we know it; if you're interested in exploring this further, I really recommend Freddy Silva's book, *The Missing Lands*, where he goes very deeply into a lot of the evidence, which can't be explained, of high technology being used to build things like the pyramids and other structures around the planet in ways that we couldn't build today, and how through very, very clever language analysis, Freddy has tied together a whole lot of mythologies around the world. He's painted a very clear picture, which also correlates to stories from the Bible about supernatural beings showing up and all those sorts of things.

Nyck: Pretty well in just about every culture on the planet going back millennia, these traces of the same stories exist there.

Steve: Yes, and Gregg Braden's work also is wonderful, in his talks where he looks at the human genome and how particularly part of it has clearly been altered—I think it's gene number 2. You can look up by Gregg Braden's work if you want to explore that.

So what we were told in the video is that this Crystalline Grid was actually laid down by advanced beings way back before the books were written, and it stores a record of human activity, and particularly it responds to our emotions. In a scientific sense, what that means is it responds to our electromagnetic field, and when we go through a strong emotional experience, it makes a change in our electromagnetic field and this Crystalline Grid responds to that and actually stores that information in a grid which is part of planet Earth. Essentially it's not a physical crystal grid, so we're not talking about physical crystals, but we're talking about a grid that has the nature of crystals—crystalline—in that it responds to and can remember variances in electromagnetic fields.

Nyck: I guess it means that crystals, as in the New Age idea about this, are themselves representatives or analogues of this Crystalline Grid itself; crystals themselves have these aspects or capacities.

Steve: They have the same qualities, yes. These crystals have the same qualities and that's why it's called a crystalline grid, because it has the qualities of physical crystals.

Lee was saying that the frequency of the Crystalline Grid is a measure of the state of the Earth and the wellbeing of the Earth, and he made reference to the 1987 Harmonic Convergence, which I guess some of our listeners may have actually been involved in. I think you were, weren't you?

Nyck: Yes, August 16th-17th, 1987. It was the first time I came to Byron, actually, or the second time, was for that weekend. There was a bunch of us up at the lighthouse there with some light rain falling on that evening of the 16th, I guess it was, and tuned to that particular resonance that we didn't really understand, but clearly, there was something that drew us and many people right around the world and all sorts of places. If you're into that world, then you would be very aware of that.

Steve: Lee was saying in this video—Lee and Monika—that that gathering in 1987 actually had quite a large impact on the Earth's crystalline grid, being responsive as it is to human activity. Many of you would have probably heard of Ley lines. These are the energy lines that geomancers or diviners will sense. Have you ever tried divining?

Nyck: I have tried divining. I have, and it seems to work sometimes—with a forked stick.

Steve: It does.

Nyck: Yeah, I know, it's amazing. Old fellas out there in the country use it to find water all the time, it's quite true; and it's not always accurate, but often it is.

Steve: Yes. When I was flying the rescue helicopter up in Mackay, years ago, the engineer that worked with me in the hangar there, he just showed me very simply with a couple of coat hangers, how to divine, and it seemed to work.

Nyck: Did you find your coat?

Steve: Well, no. At the time, I was living—I had a small orchard about 20 kilometres out of town where I lived—and I had a problem with the irrigation system. I decided to try this out, so I got a couple of coat hangers, and what happened was there was a leak in the system somewhere and I had to try and find where the underground pipe was to repair it, right? So I did this thing and I was bloody spot on. The wires crossed over, and I dug down straight there, and there was the break in the pipe.

Nyck: It's amazing how many people with these simple things that are like old wisdoms, are still not received or accepted by the majority of people.

Steve: I know, yes. It's regarded as magic or crazy stuff.

Nyck: Yes, crazy stuff. Hello out there. If you're thinking this is all crazy stuff—I know you do, some of you out there—hello. Thanks for staying with us, nevertheless.

Steve: It actually works, and that's what we like to see—things that do work. And so if you've read about Ley lines, Ley lines do not relate to the magnetic grid that compasses point to, which we mentioned earlier—they relate to this Crystalline Grid.

Nyck: Mmmm, that's interesting.

Steve: And this grid is essentially influenced and laid down by human activity. It made me think this morning over breakfast that we're often told that ancient civilisations built castles and temples and things on the intersection of Ley lines, but this kind of adds an extra complexity to it, because if human activity generates the record in the Ley line, it could be that the human traffic going to and from these buildings actually created the Ley line, or at least reinforced it.

Nyck: Of course, in the UK, they're also called Dragon Lines, which is interesting—the whole mythology there. As you're speaking, I'm thinking, well, that dragon energy—the representative of that idea—is actually a creation of human imagination, of thought, of intuition, perhaps; of the creative aspect of ourselves as represented by the dragon, and the lines themselves are the same. Perhaps they were created literally from the placing of significant buildings where significant, energetic things happen; a significant emotional or other human activity occurred.

Steve: Yes, and certainly if the Ley lines aren't created purely from human activity, they would certainly be reinforced by those sorts of things being built on, and human gathering's and altered states of consciousness happening in those places.

So this Crystalline Grid remembers human activity. They said in the video that it actually stores memories of whole lives, and so when we live a life on Earth, essentially the record of that life is stored in this Crystalline Grid. They were very clear to point out that this is a multi-dimensional place—it's not a physical place in the centre of the earth—but it made me think of the many stories that you read about on the web of people talking about people living inside the Earth, and portals, and people coming out of the Earth and this kind of thing. It very much fits with this explanation of a crystalline grid that stores memory. Monika Muranyi, in particular, spoke specifically about ghosts and hauntings being the replaying of events on this Crystalline Grid, and that makes so much sense, you know, where you get stories of a house that's haunted, where every night a lady in a white dress walked in the corridor or whatever it is, and makes a cup of tea. When we experience those things, what we're actually tapping into is a record. It essentially is just like a record playing loop from this Crystalline Grid, and of course, some of us are more sensitive to these things than others, which just adds to the controversy because those who aren't sensitive tend to think that they don't exist.

Nyck: But you can to experience that, as he says, in various ways: fluctuations in light, cold temperatures, strange feelings, changes in gravity, all sorts of things like that. I think many of us have experienced these kind of things at different times, in different places that are unfamiliar. You just have that moment where you just know something's not quite right and there's some feeling there.

Steve: Yes, I think many of us have walked into a building or visited a place at some point and just got that unusual feeling that there was something special about it or something had happened there. Often you can't quite put your finger on what it is, but what's actually happening, according to this wonderful explanation, is that we are sensing this Crystalline Grid—this storage place, a place of memory, the memory of past human activity where things can play back in loops.

Later on, before the end of the show, we'll talk briefly about the overlapping of these different grids that we're discussing and how that can contribute the sorts of events such as the looping of past energetic activities. Things like seances and these sorts of things where people were trying to get in touch with ghosts—I jumped on Amazon after watching this thing and looked at these EMF devices that Lee was talking about, and some of them were actually sold as ghost hunting devices.

Nyck: Oh really? That's great.

Steve: Isn't it interesting? Because you get fluctuations in the magnetic field and fluctuations in temperature and all sorts of things around these kinds of events. So that's all really interesting. I found that quite enlightening, actually, and it explains a whole lot—that there is this remembrance grid that we can tap into and sense and that records all of the things that happen here on our planet.

Then the third grid that they mentioned, they called the Gaia Grid and they said that the Crystalline Grid and the Gaia Grid overlap in that there's sort of a shared function there. There's something in the Crystalline Grid that they called the Cave of Creation, which is, I guess, not a literal cave, but it's a term that somebody's coined to explain the function of storing past lives in this crystalline, energetic structure. The Cave of Creation, they say, is also part of this Gaia Grid, and the Gaia Grid was described as a partnership grid—some multidimensional thing—so it's not a physical thing that we're talking about here. It's an interdimensional thing. It's situated in the Earth and it holds wisdom. Again, it's responsive to human experience and human wisdom. In fact, elements of human consciousness are actually stored in this Gaia Grid, and interestingly, can be recalled, and this this, again, explains the behaviour of our ancestors who would sit in sacred places and do what they said was getting in touch with their ancestors and receiving wisdom. Essentially what they're doing is interacting with this magnetic grid, this Gaia Grid, which is a place where wisdom from human consciousness is stored and can be called. So that's very interesting.

Nyck: Song lines.

Steve: Yes. And also, they related this Gaia Grid to the phenomena of seeing what are called elementals like fairies—little people; the Irish would understand what I'm talking about there—and all of those strange things of seeing little people in the forest.

Nyck: And also plant consciousness itself, which of course is something that many people around this area are investigating as well; and a lot of places like Damanhur in Italy, if you're familiar with that place, where they can measure literally the singing of plants; the communication of plants, all those aspects.

Steve: Yes.

These three grids make up the Earth's energy structure. The Magnetic Grid, which is pretty easy to get your head around because we're all familiar with compasses and measuring it, and the fact that the Magnetic Grid has a quite a remarkable impact on human consciousness—and you might say that the health of human beings is dependent upon exposure to this Magnetic Grid; the Crystalline Grid, which is a place that stores human emotions and human activity and is responsible for what we call Ley lines of energy, which can be detected by dowsers, and also stores evidence of memory of past lives that have been lived on the Earth that exist on an interdimensional plane; and then the Gaia Grid, which is like a wisdom grid, very similar to the Crystalline Grid in many ways, but specifically

holds wisdom that we can interact with and can call up in the same way that our indigenous ancestors used to do that. In this video that I watched, both Monika and Lee were encouraging us to start reengaging with these things, and this fits very much with one of the previous topics that we had on the show a few weeks back where I spoke about Second Tier consciousness being the new indigenous way of living, where we're reconnecting with the planet and re-establishing our connection and communication with these energetic features of our planet, which we've kind of lost over the past few years.

So we might take a quick break and we'll come back and finally talk about some grid overlapping effects.

Nyck: We'll come back after this.

A couple of texts have come in: "Thanks for the mention of the 12th Planet by Zecharia Sitchin." Yes, we're aware of that; that's a big topic in itself. And then this is interesting from someone who works in town here: "Hey, guys, I work in town water supply and we use charged silver solder sticks the way Steve described to find water leaks. It works and anybody can learn how to do it."

Steve: It sure does, there you go.

Nyck: Very cool, very good.

Steve: That's great. Thank you for that.

Nyck: Yep. We'll take a break. We'll be back very shortly here on *Future Sense*.

Steve: And we're just wrapping up our discussion of the Earth's grids: the Magnetic Grid, the Crystalline Grid, which is like a remembrance grid of a crystalline nature in that it remembers and stores human experience, and the Gaia Grid, which Lee and Monika called a partnership grid, which is a place that holds wisdom and a place that we can interact with.

I just want to talk very briefly about grid overlap effects now. So these three grids, of course, interact with each other, and that interaction can result in what are known as nulls or nodes—a node being like a masculine place where energy is emitted, or a null being like a feminine place, which you could think of as like a sinkhole or an absorber of energy vortices—and also interdimensional portals. I guess the most famous of these is probably the Bermuda Triangle. It's well known that aircraft and ships going into the Bermuda Triangle in the past have found that their magnetic devices behave in strange ways. It's essentially a place where these three grids interact in a certain way to create an interdimensional portal.

This is stuff that we don't understand from a scientific point of view at all at the moment, but this information that we're relaying today is part of a bridge that we're building from solid science to a new understanding of magnetism and interdimensional fields.

So when we get an overlap of these grids, if you turn up in one of these places, it can feel really nice, but it can also feel uncomfortable, depending on the nature of the interaction of the grids. The grids can either be amplified or they can nullify each other; you can get strange anomalies like the Bermuda Triangle where you get weird interdimensional activity and the disturbance of magnetic devices; and also another way that we could experience this is through the impact it has on Ley lines as we know them through the process of dowsing.

Right at the end of the video—and I will post a link to this video if you want to take a look at it; I recommend it (<https://streamingforthesoul.com/earths-energy-grids-lee-and-monika/>)—right at the end of the video, Kryon channelled a bit of information, and very quickly, I'll summarise that information. He just said that we are multidimensional beings surrounded by multidimensional energies and entities, and as I said at the start of this segment of the show, we are evolving towards a greater awareness of, and more interaction with, other dimensions of reality. There's no doubt about that whatsoever.

Nyck: Even if you don't know it, it's probably happening to you in some way.

Steve: You will know, eventually. From Kryon's channelling, just a couple of other points here: Gaia's energy is the biggest energy that we experience on this planet. It's always present and we need to start becoming more mindful of that and aware of the fact that we can interact with that magnetic field and gain wisdom from it.

Nyck: We're actually a partner in that—with the fields of the Earth; with Gaia's intelligence.

Steve: Yes, and our ancestors did exactly that to gain day-to-day information about where they might hunt, what the weather was going to be like and all those sorts of things. Kryon was making the point that we can start to do this again, and as I mentioned, this really is representative of the emergence of Second Tier consciousness where we get a replay of the indigenous living theme, and so we will become like a new indigenous humanity with the benefit of all of our science that's been added in the meantime. Kryon made the point that you don't need to be in the bush, you don't need to be in the countryside to experience this. You can experience it in the city, too, and our inherent access to these fields in this information is mostly been lost because we've just been disconnected from it for cultural reasons. It's been trained out of us and it's time for us to reclaim it.

Nyck: Beautiful. A couple of final texts on this topic: "Some time ago, I was using a meter to test the radiation from mobile phones and I found there was a measurable radiation up to half a metre, even with the phone turned off." Thanks for that, Dudley. Interesting.

And Trace has written it again and said: "Get a geo-cleanse." Well, yeah, OK.

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
